Instructions for the presentation:

Each group of students will be given 15 minutes for their presentation, followed by 5 minutes for comentaries.

Upload to the **Final Review** group in **Archnet** up to 8 400x600pixels JPG images explaining the following:

1. Justify the design chosen from the possible designs generated by the given spatial relation.
2. Explain which strategy was used in interpreting the volumes for the different house functions.
3. Explain how the proportions of the blocks in the given spatial relation were changed to fit particular needs.
4. Show your final architectural design: plans, sections and a perspective besides the original shape grammar model.
5. Match your final design with the site plan developed in the first exercise (re-creating the 2D grammar if necessary).

In your oral explanation, evaluate the 2 main issues in this course:

- (a) how helpful the use of grammars was in solving this particular design problem and
- (b) how efficient the consulting and critiques from your overseas partners was in helping to design houses in a remote place.
